Ottawa, Ont., April 30.—The personnel of the commission which is to inquire into the grain trade was announced this evening. The chairman is Mr. Justice Turgeon of the Supreme Court of Saskatchewan, and the other members are Dean Rutherford, of the faculty of Agriculture, University of Saskatchewan, Dr. McGibbon, professor of economics, University of Alberta, and James G. Scott, of Quebec, an authority on transportation questions.
