NO RESTRICTION ON VENDORS AS TO WHERE TO BUY

N. B. Government Declines Proposal of Chief Inspector

Announcement of Statement by Premier Foster Comes from Fredericton—Reported Suggestion to Limit Sale of Extract

(Canadian Press) Fredericton, N. B., Nov. 12.—The government will not seek to restrict licensed vendors from purchasing liquor from any source where they can legally do so, declared Premier Foster in an official statement this morning.

Recently announced was made that, in the new regulations in conjunction with the prohibition act submitted for the approval of the government by Rev. W. D. Wilson as chief inspector, was one which limited the retail vendors to buying from the St. John wholesale drug companies holding licenses, thus shutting out concerns outside the province.

Wholesale liquor concerns in Montreal, so soon as they learned of this, retained legal representatives and commenced to get ready to fight the proposal in the courts, if it met with the approval of the government.

Other suggestions by the chief inspector have not yet been considered by the government, but will probably be taken up this afternoon or this evening.

Included in the long list is said to be one which limits the quantity of a extract which can be sold to 2½ ounces a person daily.

REST FOR THE PRINCE

Taking it Easy This Afternoon in Washington

First Day in U. S. Capital was a Strenuous One—He Gives Message of Greeting to American People

REST FOR THE PRINCE

Washington, Nov. 12.—The Prince of Wales concluded his first day of his visit to the United States with a message of greeting to the American people in which he paid a warm tribute to the part played in the war by the army and navy of the United States. He delivered his message in person at the National Press Club and it marked the termination of probably as strenuous a day as the young heir to the British throne has spent since he landed on the American continent.

The prince started his second day here with a visit to the national headquarters of the American Red Cross. Afterwards he inspected the Lincoln memorial and visited the Walter Reed Hospital, where he met wounded soldiers.

The afternoon was left free for the prince to spend as he pleased as he wished to secure some rest after the strenuous two hours yesterday.

Ottawa, Nov. 12.—To commemorate the placing of the corner stone in the peace tower by the Prince of Wales, a marble bust and pedestal of the prince will be erected in the new parliament building. The model shows the prince in military dress. His expression is tinged with a slight smile that lights up his whole face.

TWO DEATHS OCCUR IN WINNIPEG FROM THE "SLEEPING SICKNESS"

Winnipeg, Nov. 12.—Dr. J. Gordon Bell, provincial bacteriologist, announced yesterday that two deaths had occurred in the city from letiargic cephalitis, or "sleeping sickness." Four other persons are under treatment. The doctor asserts there is no cause for alarm of epidemic. It is not considered the true form of "sleeping sickness" prevalent in South Africa.

SMALLPOX PATIENTS IN TORONTO NOW 236

Toronto, Nov. 12.—This city last night had 236 smallpox patients on its hands and more than 700 persons in quarantine as a result of exposure. Compulsory vaccination has not been decided upon yet, but all the school children of the city are being inoculated.

BOY CONFESSES ATTEMPT TO BURN DOWN THE ST. FRANCIS XAVIER COLLEGE

Sydney, Nov. 12.—A frebug was caught red-handed at St. Francis Xavier College on Monday. He is a young student belonging to Cape Breton. He was caught in the basement getting ready to set another fire last night. The boy confessed to setting a fire on September 25, which damaged one of the college buildings, and was seen in time to prevent the building being destroyed. He also said that he intended to do this time. When pressed for his motive the boy said he wanted to get home.

Without wavin', bursts of rifle fire swept the ranks of marching overseas veterans as they paraded past I. W. W. headquarters. From that building and the roof of a building across the street bullets came. Persons in the crowds that lined the streets also drew weapons and began firing. Grimms, leading a company of men, dropped mortally wounded. McElfresh, marching in the ranks, was killed instantly. Ben Casagrande died later from the wounds. The fourth death was added when Dale Hubbard, recently returned overseas man, gathered a small band and started after the I. W. W. society. The Hubbard group and the fugitives grappled after a chase. Smith fired repeatedly at his pursuers. As they clined, Hubbard received four wounds in the body. Another pursuer overpowered Smith and he was taken to jail, later to be removed and hanged after citizens learned that four of the former soldiers had been killed.

An attempt to lynch Smith was made before he was lodged in the jail. "You fellows can't hang me," he said. "I was sent to do my duty and I did it."

Hanged Over Bridge.

Smith was tossed from a bridge over the Chelchah River after a rope was tied about his neck and a volley of bullets sent into his body. The lynching party worked silently and in darkness. At 7:30 all the city's electric lights were cut off and eight men easily overcame the one man on guard inside the jail. Smith was placed in one of about six darkened automobiles that stood about the jail and rushed to the bridge.

Little was known of Smith. He came here a short time ago. Two Kennedy referees to handle his body and what disposal of it would be made was unknown.

CRUELTY TO ANIMALS CASE, A MILITARY ONE AND ALLEGATION OF POCKET-BOOK SNATCHING

A case against Frank McMurray, John McGuire and William Godsoe, charged with beating and injuring horses of William F. Kiernan on the night of September 26, was resumed in the police court this morning. Frank Murphy, driver for Mr. Kiernan, said the three defendants were in the barn that evening when he found that the horses were badly cut and ridden. Charles Hawker said that the horses were in a bruised and injured condition. He said he thought the three defendants were under the influence of liquor.

Serg. Rankine said he saw the horses on the morning of September 27, and the grey horse's ramp was covered with cuts and bruises. The case was postponed until Friday morning at eleven o'clock. J. A. Barry appeared for the prosecution, while G. Earle Logan was for the defence.

L. A. Chaplaid was charged with being without leave from the military police corps from May 5, 1918, until November 3, 1918. He said that he was a member of the first division, went to France and was returned home and discharged in December, 1917. In February, 1918, he re-enlisted in the military police corps and was transferred to Woodstock. While there, he became discouraged, and decided to leave everything and pursue a civilian life. He went to the United States and came back about three months ago and worked in the city. A short time ago he went to Moncton and was arrested there by the military police.

The magistrate said that on account of the war being over he did not feel inclined to carry out the penalty and sent the man to Dorchester penitentiary for two years.

The assistant provost marshal, Captain R. L. H. Goodday, said that the war being over had nothing to do with this case. The magistrate brought up the question of a permanent force in Canada, and said he was not in favor of it, as it was too much of the German idea. He said he hoped that from now on Canada would live a civil life. The matter was laid over for consideration, and the accused remanded.
