PROGRAMME FOR ADMIRAL'S VISIT

A meeting was held yesterday with Hon. W. Pugsley, lieutenant-governor, in the chair, to arrange for the visit of Admiral of the Fleet Viscount Jellicoe. There were present His Worship the Mayor, Colonel Sturges, president of the navy league; Captain Muleshey, Hon. W. E. Foster, R. B. Emerson, C. B. Allen and C. Roman. The governor announced that he had received a telegram from the admiral that he will arrive here on Thursday next at noon and that he had accepted an invitation from the Navy League to address them in the evening. After some discussion it was decided that he be taken to the dry dock on arrival, then for a cruise on the harbor, returning after 5 o'clock; at 7 o'clock the city will give him a dinner at the Union Club and at 9 o'clock a mass meeting will be held at the Imperial under the auspices of the Navy League and the Canadian Clubs, and at which Lord Jellicoe will speak. The chair will be taken by the president of the navy league. After the address, Hon. Sir Douglas Hazen will speak, and, if there is time, a reception will be held on the stage. The lower floor will be reserved for members of the navy league

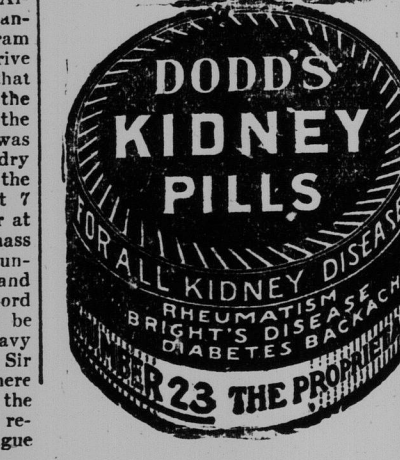
