ANTI-FLU SERUM FOUND IN PARIS

Type B Vaccine Being Per-
fected by Pasteur Institute.

The famous Pasteur Institute in Paris

is now perfecting a vaccine called "Type
B," which is expected to rid the world
definitely of influenza epidemics.

The vaccine contains 14,000,000,000
dead bacilli per cubic centimeter. It can
be used both for cure and prevention.

One sub-cutaneous injection of from
one-half to two cubic centimeters has
been found sufficient to keep a healthy
person immune for the period of the
epidemic.

One injection a day, from one-fourth
of a cubic centimeter on the first day,
to two cubic centimeters on the fourth day,
when the danger point is passed, is de-
clared sufficient to cure the "flu" as well
as the resultant bronchial pneumonia.

When a patient's life is in extreme
danger, the effect of the vaccine treat-
ment is increased by additional sub-
cutaneous and intra-venal hypodermic
injections, with a new anti-pneumonic
serum called "Type 11," obtained from
animal bacilli causing bronchial pneu-
monia.

As a matter of fact, the use of this
serum is declared probably unnecessary in
the majority of cases, even severe
ones. The doctor doctors declare that
the "flu" sufferers they have treated with
the "Type B" vaccine have invariably
recovered.
