

UNIVERSITY OF KING'S COLLEGE, WINDSOR, NOVA SCOTIA.

An Act of Parliament was passed in 1789 for the establishment of "King's College of Nova Scotia," in accordance with the recommendation of a Committee of the House of Assembly, November, 1787. The College was opened in 1790, and a Royal Charter was granted by His Majesty King George III, in 1802.
