NEW YORK'S POLYGLOT PAPERS REPRESENT HUGE INVESTMENT

Dailies and Weeklies in Twenty-eight Languages are Published in Gotham -- An Investment of \$27,000,000 Represented.

(New York Sun.) In this city there are prosperous newspapers published in twenty-eight foreign languages.

Of the other eighteen languages and dialects, not counting German, represented by newspapers in New York, the Arabic peoples, who number about 40,000, are the only ones to have a journal.

The Lithuanians, who are Russian in the United States, number 25,000, have one weekly, the Scandinavian, Norwegian, Swedes, and Danes, numbering 40,000, have three weekly newspapers.

There are a million Jews in New York, more than there ever were in Jerusalem, and nearly 600,000 Italians in Chicago.

Russian Jews are omnivorous readers, as is indicated by the fact that their four leading newspapers in New York reach a total circulation of more than 300,000.

Next in importance to the Yiddish newspapers among those published in New York are the Italian ones.
