TRAIN WRECKED ON **ALBERT-SALISBURY BRANCH FRIDAY**

Salisbury, Oct. 5.—The train on the Albert-Salisbury branch, leaving here Friday afternoon, jumped the rails on the down trip from here and went into a bad pile up. After leaving the trails the train travelled several rods, tearing up the road bed, cutting ties and twisting steel. The passengers and mails were transferred to Albert by automobiles.
