keep all accounts, and pay to the individual locatee all profits that may be derived from his land.

I worked hard to get the Band to consent to surrender the whole Reserve at once but it was no use they will not do so, I am informed that a number of oil men are on the Reserve looking for land to lease and that in a few days I would be handed some of these leases to send to the Department, if I get any such I will forward them to the Department and you will then see just what the Indians want, I enclose copy of the Resolution passed by the general Indian Council on the 8th ultimo.
