Sarnia in the County of Lambton, Province of Ontario and Dom-  
inion of Canada~~ containing by admeasurement seventy eight  
hundredths of an acre be the same more or less, being composed  
part of St. Andrew street, described as follows;:-

Commencing at the south east corner of lot nine  
range four, thence south thirty two degrees and thirty seven  
minutes west along the west limit of Park street produced  
one chain and twenty-one links more or less to the southerly  
limit of St Andrew street; thence south fifty seven degrees  
along said south limit  
twenty-five minutes east, six chains and forty-seven links  
more or less to the west limit of Dufferin avenue; thence  
north thirty two degrees and thirty seven minutes east along  
the said west limit of Dufferin avenue one chain and twenty-  
one links more or less to the south east corner of lot nine  
range six; thence north fifty seven degrees twenty-five min-  
utes west along the northerly limit of St Andrew street six  
chains and forty seven links more or less to the place of  
beginning, as said parcel of land is shown on a plan of sub-  
division of ~~park~~ of the Sarnia Indian Reserve ceded in 1875  
as surveyed by J.J. Francis, P.L.S. dated at Sarnia on the  
nineteenth day of February, 1878, and of record in the Depart-  
ment of Indian Affairs.
