useful exertion, we are not able in fact to overtake the work to which we are invited. In our missions alone, "Come over and help us," is the voice from almost every quarter. The vineyard of the Lord lies before his labourers and we are thus called by the force of principle—by the glow of feeling—by the power of pity—by the ardour of hope—by the sublime scenes and prospects which the mighty operations of Providence among the nations of the earth now spread around us—by our loyalty, and by our love to Christ to be stedfast, unmoveable always abounding in the work of the Lord and the more so, as we know that our labour is not in vain in the Lord.
