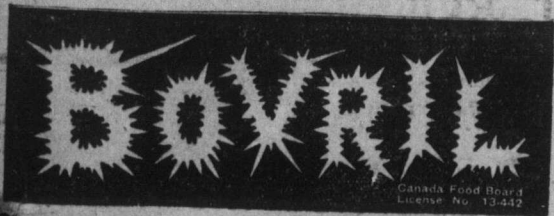

MARATHON RACE AT ANTWERP TO BE RUN ON PAVED ROAD

The Marathon race at the Olympic games at Antwerp, Belgium, next summer promises to be fully as severe a test on the stamina of the contenders as was the Stockholm-Solentuna and return run at the Stockholm Olympics in 1912.

It is proposed to run the 1920 Marathon from Brussels to Antwerp—a distance approximately twenty-six miles. The road over which the plodders will battle for the distance classic is an excellent one—for automobiles. The entire distance is paved with asphalt and Belgian blocks which are first cousins to cobblestones. This footing is not going to work any hardship against the chances of the Canadian and American representatives, most of whom are accustomed to hustling along over city pavements, but it will be none the less easy on the feet and leg muscles of the contenders.

ROBBERS AT MONTREAL

MONTREAL, Dec. 22.—Early Saturday morning three masked and armed men, using keys, opening the door of 85 City Hall Ave., awakened three men and at the point of the revolver robbed the boarding house keeper of \$130 and the two boarders William Quiddy and A. Benoit of \$400. They beat up the boarding house keeper and one of the boarders so badly that they had to be taken to the hospital.

ONLY NINETEEN SURVIVORS.

New York, Dec. 22.—Nineteen survivors of the British steamer Manxman, which founded 400 miles off the Nova Scotia coast on December 18, arrived here on Sunday on the British steamer British Isles. They were picked up from a lifeboat and a raft. The party included the second officer, five of the engine-room crew, the chief steward, one of the firemen and eleven seamen.

The Captain and all the other members of the crew of 59 perished. In Lapland the babies are wrapped in furs and buried in the snow outside the church while their parents attend the services.
