Was leader of Ontario Opposition in House of Commons from the Union until 1873 when elected Leader of the whole Opposition party and continued in that position until 5 Nov. 1873, when, owing to the resignation of Sir John Macdonald, he was called on to form a new Administration, a duty he succeeded in accomplishing on 7th of the same month, when he and his colleagues were sworn of the Privy Council. He (Mr. M.) taking the office of Minister of Public Works.
