

CHAPTER 112.

An Act respecting Oaths of Allegiance.

A. D. 1886.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :---

1. The following form and no other, shall be that of the Form of oath oath of allegiance to be administered to and taken by every per- prescribed. son in Canada, who, either of his own accord or in compliance with any lawful requirement made on him, or in obedience to the directions of any Act or law in force in Canada, save and except "The British North America Act, 1867," desires to take an oath of allegiance, that is to say:

"I, A. B., do sincerely promise and swear that I will be The form.

"faithful and bear true allegiance to Her Majesty Queen "Victoria (or reigning Sovereign for the time being) as lawful "Sovereign of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and "Ireland, and of this Dominion of Canada, dependent on and "belonging to the said Kingdom, and that I will defend Her "to the utmost of my power against all traitorous conspi-"racies or attempts whatsoever, which shall be made against "Her person, crown and dignity, and that I will do my "utmost endeavor to disclose and make known to Her Ma-"jesty, Her heirs or successors, all treasons or traitorous "conspiracies and attempts which I shall know to be against "Her or any of them; and all this I do swear without any "equivocation, mental evasion or secret reservation. So help " me God."

And all justices of the peace and other officers lawfully Who may adauthorized, either by virtue of their office or special commis-minister it. sion from the Crown for that purpose, may administer the oath of allegiance under this Act in any part of Canada; and No other deit shall not be necessary for any person appointed to any subscription civil office in Canada, or for any mayor or other officer or necessary. member of any corporation therein, or for any person admitted, called or received as a barrister, advocate, notary public, attorney, solicitor or proctor, to make any declaration or subscription, or to take or subscribe any other oath than the oath aforesaid, and also such oath for the faithful perform- Oath of office ance of the duties of his office, or for the due exercise of his to be taken. profession or calling as is required by any law in that behalf. 31 V., c. 36, s. 3.
