

Mr. Brodeur reported the Resolution accordingly, and the same was read, as followeth :—

Resolved, That towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty, on account of certain expenses of the Public Service, for the financial year ending the 30th June, 1897, the sum of \$14,633,167.18 be granted out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada.

The said Resolution, being read a second time, was agreed to.

Mr. Brodeur also acquainted the House that he was directed to move, That the Committee may have leave to sit again.

Resolved, That this House will, on Monday next, again resolve itself into the said Committee.

Ordered, That Mr. Fielding have leave to bring in a Bill, for granting to Her Majesty certain sums of money required for defraying certain expenses of the Public Service, for the financial year ending the 30th June, 1897, and for other purposes relating to the Public Service.

He accordingly presented the said Bill to the House, and the same was received and read the first time.

Ordered, That the Bill be now read a second time.

The Bill was accordingly read a second time ; and committed to a Committee of the Whole House.

Resolved, That this House do immediately resolve itself into the said Committee.

The House accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee, and, after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair ; and Mr. Brodeur reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and directed him to report the same without any amendment.

Ordered, That the Bill be read the third time on Monday next.

On motion of Mr. Laurier, seconded by Mr. Davies,

Resolved, That when the House adjourns this day, it do stand adjourned until Monday next, at Eleven o'Clock in the morning.

Mr. Speaker acquainted the House, That a Message had been brought from the Senate by their Clerk, as followeth :—

The Senate have passed the following Bills without any amendment :—

Bill intituled : “ An Act to incorporate the Mather Bridge and Power Company.”

Bill intituled : “ An Act further to amend the Act respecting the Senate and “ House of Commons.”

Bill intituled : “ An Act to amend the North-west Territories Representation Act “ by dispensing with the preparation of new voters' lists in certain cases.”
