

shall have been referred to him, then a new umpire shall be appointed in the manner before provided, who shall, in like manner, proceed and make his award within sixty days or in default be superseded and so *toties quoties*.

- 5 **14.** In the case of all awards made under this Act, such award shall specify in the form of a mileage rate, per train mile for each description of service required to be performed, the amount to be payable by the Post Office to the Railway Company in respect to which the award is made, for the conveyance of Mails by the said Railway in the manner required by the Postmaster General. Award to specify a mileage rate for the service required.
- 10 **15.** All pecuniary penalties imposed by this Act shall be recoverable with costs by the Postmaster General, in like manner with pecuniary penalties imposed by the Post Office Act. Recovery of penalties.
- 15 **16.** The term "Railway Company" used in this Act shall be held to include and apply to any person or persons in possession of a Railway coming under the provisions of this Act, or controlling the working of the same. What shall be a "Railway Company" under this Act.
- 20 **17.** This Act shall be deemed a Post Office Act and be subject, as regards the meaning of the several terms used in relation to the Post Office, to the interpretation clauses of the Post Office Act. Interpretation clause.
