uva (the root is: *u*) there (pointing) = LCMWnsa.

Drv. G. *una* that there (derived immediately from the root), plur. *uko*, *ukoa*; *umînga* by that, *umunga* to that. — M. *una*, *okkoa*, *umînga*, *omnua*. — Ws. *oona*.

*uvâ** (?) Wn. *wak!* *wqa!* yes.

ûvaq the smaller codfish = LCWn.

*ûvakaq** Wn. *uakak* south, noon. — Ws. *vagak*, *ooagtok* south; *ovagak* southwind.

uvanga I. me, plur. *uvagut* = LCMWnsa. (*ooanga*, *woonga*, *chovy*, *chivanga*, *wy*. *uankuta*).

*ovasag** Ws. *oaschak*, *oosiak* north: *ovasakak* northwind.

uvatse stop, wait a little! = LCWs.

uvâvfaq Ge. (snail?) shell (L. *ubvertok* a small shell, muscle).
