The Faculty of Physics maintains an observatory right here on the U of A campus, on the top floor of the Physics building.

"Every Friday night the observatory is open to the public," says Dr. Hube, an associate professor in the Physics department, who is also in charge of operating the observatory.

"It is somewhat of an informal approach depending on how many people are around and sky conditions," he explains.


In the observatory people can learn the general principles of optics via a demonstration of the telescope. If the sky conditions are clear, anyone may use the telescope to explore the universe.

"We also have a fairly extensive display area," Hube adds.

The observatory is one of the few public relations facilities located and operated on campus during the academic year.

"We also take tours of groups, like Boy Scouts, on other nights of the week," he says.

"Last year we had just over a thousand visitors. We had 2000 our first year of the program because of a fairly extensive publicity program."
