Ottawa, July 25, 1913.

Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 18th inst., No. 9616, in which you state that the Indian resident on the land in the Nipissing Indian Reserve required for ballast pit, has arranged to accept \$65.00 for his buildings. Please note that in letter of the 23rd April last that his clearings, the area of which were not known, have been valued at \$55.00 per acre and it was desired that your engineer should ascertain the area of these clearings. The sum to be paid for the proposed ballast <sup>pit</sup> will be estimated as follows:-

43.87 acres at \$15.00 per acre

Clearings at \$55.00 " "

Buildings as agreed upon \$65.00.

Please note that the \$55.00 per acre for the clearing is in addition to the price of the land itself at \$15.00 per acre.
