All that parcel of land situate in "The Pas" townplot in the surrendered portion of The Pas Indian Reserve in the ~~Province of Saskatchewan~~ ^{North West Territories} and Dominion of Canada containing together by admeasurement one acre and eight thousand four hundred and twenty-five ten thousandths of an acre more or less ~~being composed of~~ the right of way of the Finger Lumber Company spur through blocks fifty-one, fifty-two, ~~and fifty-five~~, forty-six, forty-seven, forty-eight, and lot one block thirty-nine and lots three, four fourteen and fifteen block forty of said townplot, which may be more particularly described as a strip of land fifty feet wide ^{that is to say twenty-five feet in width} on each side of the centre line of said right of way through said blocks which said centre line may be described as follows:-

Firstly-

Commencing at a point thirty-six feet and three tenths of a foot measured south thirty-five degrees and six minutes east along the west limit of Lathlin Avenue from the north-east corner of block fifty-one, thence approximately south twenty-six degrees and twenty minutes ^{west} ~~east~~ two hundred and sixteen feet, thence on a four degree curve to the left to the east limit of Cook Avenue, including a width of twenty-five feet on each side and excepting thereout that part taken by the right of way of the Hudson Bay Railway and containing three ~~xxxxx~~ thousand four hundred and eighty-eight ten thousandths of an acre more or less.
