With reference to your note on Insp. Chitty's memorandum of July 20th, I have to say that provision would have to be made in the Estimates to the extent of \$600,000 in order to carry out the proposed exchange. In this connection I would refer you to File 25421 and the Deputy Minister's note on the memoranda referring to the land purchase at Truro. I would suggest that we act along the lines of the Deputy's memorandum wherever it is possible to do so.
