Paid to himself and repaid to h^o 21, non compos, formerly paid with h^o 22.

Paid to himself. married to a daughter of h^o 37.

Dead.

Paid to himself, wife and one child absent, four boys and one girl dead.

Comeillor, Paid to himself, girl supposed to be married to an Indian of the Lake of the Woods, and one boy also at the Lake of the Woods.

Comeillor, Paid to himself, Children living at Red Lake among their relations.

Across the line with his family, - was expected but did not come.

Paid to himself, other relations across the line.

Man drowned and children said to be at Turtle Mountain.

Paid to herself, boy absent, claims to be married to a Broken Head Indian Wessingah.
