



Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 17th inst. in which you ask for explanations as to why you have not been paid interest or annuity money, I beg to say that the Michipicoten Band of which you are a member has not received a distribution of interest money for three years. You are not entitled to draw Robinson Treaty money although your wife has a right to ~~payment~~ payment. She was paid when the last distribution of Robinson Treaty money was made.
