




Sir:-

In further reference to your letter of the 10th January last relative to the annuity payments to the Indians of your Agency this year; I beg to state that the Air Board will not be able to undertake the transportation of the Treaty Party to the Chemawawin, Moose Lake, Cumberland, Shoal Lake and Red Earth Reserves, but it is expected that they will be able to go to Nelson House and Split Lake. It will therefore, be necessary to revise the list of dates and make other arrangements for your transport. Previous arrangements for the payments at Fort Churchill and York Factory are also cancelled, so far as you and the Dootor are concerned.

Kindly furnish the revised list of dates as soon as convenient and state what arrangements you propose to make for the transport of your party.
