- A. I don't think so, sir. It was more in self-defence.
- Q. You didn't just push him?
- A. No, sir. I didn't just push him. I hit him, because if he had hit me first I don't know what would have happened then. I probably would have taken the worst of it then.
- Q. He made no other movement other than to raise his arms to his wmist? (At this point Captain Embury objected, complaining that this was a leading question. The objection was upheld and Major Tow

Major Tow. I correct my statement. He followed you and raised his hands to about the level of his waist?

- A. Yes, sir.
- Q. What caused you to xxxix swing around?
- A. When he shouted at me, 'I don't have to take rats like you outside. I took it that he wanted to settle the matter there and then.
- Q. Where was he standing when you hit him?
- A. About the centre of my bed.

Question by Colonel Slessor.

Q. How long after Reveille was the first plow struck?

A. I would say about four minutes.
