dark. We fully deny any knowledge of same.
As we are fully aware what Sir James Douglas
gave to our old people, was not for no land
transaction whatever.
2nd We want to be recognized by the Authority
Sincerely Sincere as other Indian tribes in
the Province of British Columbia.
3rd We do not mean to say, that we want the
land back, no! - as it is settled by the settlers.
4. We want the Authority to be lenient to us. and
favor us Compensation as saw fit.
