## Act of Incorporation 27 VICTORIA

## CHAPTER XCII. (Assented to 15th October, 1863.)

An Act to incorporate the Toronto Club. Preamble WHEREAS the persons hereinafter named, with a large number of others in Toronto, and elsewhere in Upper Canada, have associated themselves for the establishment of a Club, for social purposes, and have prayed to be incorporated by the name of the "Toronto Club," and it is expedient to grant their prayer: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:
