According to Order, a Bill to amend the *Act for prohibiting the Exportation of Raw Hides, &c.* was presented to the House, and the same was read, and taken into Consideration.

According to Order, a Bill to repeal *An Act made in the 32d Year of His late Majesty's Reign, to prohibit the erecting of Distilling Houses within the Town of Halifax*, was presented to the House, and the same was read, and taken into Consideration, and agreed to with Amendments.
