Order'd, That the faid Bill be carried up to His Majesty's Council, with a Message, that this House doth agree to the fame with fome Amendments, to which they defire the Concurrence of His Majesty's Council.

Agreed to with Amendments.

According to Order, a Bill to amend the Att for prohibiting the Exportation of Raw Hides, &c. was presented to the House, and the same was read, and taken into Confideration.

Bill to amend Act for prohibi ing Exportation of Hides, presented.

According to Order, a Bill to repeal An Act made in the 32d Year of His late Majesty's Reign, to prohibit the erecting of Distilling Houses within the Town of Halifax, was presented to the House, and the same was read, and taken into Consideration, and agreed to with Amendments.

Bill to repeal Act to prohibit erecting Diftill Houles, &c.

The Committee appointed to examine the Light-House Accounts, reported to the House their proceedings therein. And the House having taken the fame into Confideration,

Report of the Committee on the Lighthouse Accounts.

Order'd, That an Address be presented to his Excellency the Governor thereon.

Then the House adjourn'd till Monday Morning Ten o'Clock.
