

## PUBLIC ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR

For Nine Months the Balance  
Over Expenditure is  
\$919,330

The promise contained in His Honor's Speech from the Throne of yesterday that the Public Accounts would be laid before the House at the earliest possible date, was redeemed within twenty minutes of His Honor's withdrawal from the Chamber, when the Hon. Mr. Bowser, Minister of Finance, presented the treasury statement, referred to. As has been previously explained, the return on this occasion (in consequence of the alteration of the provincial fiscal year) covers but the nine months extending from the 1st July, 1903, to the 31st March, 1904, instead of the usual twelvemonth, in consequence of which comparative analyses are impossible.

For the nine months of expenditure was almost \$1,000,000, to be exact \$919,330, and it is known that the ratio of increase in revenue has been continually mounting since the 31st March—the expiry period of the present return. As illustrating the present position, the Hon. Mr. Bowser, in his appended figures tell their own story.

## IS CONCLUDED FOR THE PRESENT

With but Two Ballots to Consider Local Option Loses by 1187

Beginning the third day of the official count of the Local Option plebiscite with 1,304 votes to make up, out of a total of 17,707 in order to win the required majority, the champions of what now seems for the present a lost cause in British Columbia, during yesterday's proceedings in increasing allowance out of the rejected ballots recorded to the extent of 117 in the total, the adverse figures at the close of the day to 1,187. There remains, however, but the one district of Skeena to be reviewed, the ballot boxes not yet having put in its appearance, and the completion of the count has accordingly been adjourned indefinitely, it being understood that the Deputy Provincial Secretary will notify all interested parties as soon as the delinquent ballots present themselves.

### Analysis of Result.

There have now been counted and checked by the postal representatives of both parties, a total of 46,540 votes, the aggregate gain by the Local Optionists through allowances being rejected, while about 250 ballots are understood to have been reserved, to form the basis of appeal to the Executive. The affirmative vote fell short of the required 50 per cent, originally by 1,568, so that, according to everything claimed, the allowance plus the so-called "reserved ballots" intended to be laid before the Executive council, would only slightly reduce the margin of failure—no remove it.

### Local Option Convention

On Thursday, February 10th, the annual British Columbia local option convention will be held at the Broad street hall, Victoria. Delegates will be present from all provincial centres, and the session will last throughout the day and speeches will be delivered by a number of able men on the subject in which the organization is interested. The local option is extended to all local optionists, no distinction whatever is made, everyone is interested, and with Local Option, that it would be most unwise at the present juncture for friends of Local Option, to further press the claims of that principle in B. C.

### Westminster's Fair Grounds

Former Mayor Keary and Mr. T. J. Trap, the two foremost "hatters" for the New Westminster Show, have returned home after an interview with the Premier and his colleagues, in which they urged Provincial assistance toward the improvement of the Fair Association's grounds and facilities at Horse Show Building, which could also be used for indoor stock judging, and for the purpose of holding the Premier and Hon. Dr. Young were also interviewed relative to the increasing of the annual meeting of the Royal Columbian Association. Both matters will receive consideration—probably favorable.
