OTTAWA, July 19.—An extra of the Canada Gazette published to-day contains notice of the disallowance of another Manitoba act of the Legislature. It is the act which confers the extraordinary clause that all contractors, sub-contractors and laborers, engaged on any railway or other work approved by the Commission of Public Works and Light, shall be entitled to all the protection of this provision. This is another of the acts intended to give the Local Government exclusive powers to act in building the railway to the boundary, the presumable object of this act being apparently to have contractors for the road from being served with injunctions to stop work.

A telegram was received by the Department of Fisheries to-day confirming the statement of the Hon. J. A. A. Macdonald, Minister of Fisheries, that the Associated Press despatches this morning, from Victoria, B.C., that a fisherman named John Smith, who was seized in helping sea by the United States revenue cutter "Albatross" last night, had been released. Mr. Smith, who is a Canadian, was taken aboard the "Albatross" on Thursday and is expected to return to Ottawa on Friday. It is understood that the "Albatross" is now on its way to the coast.
