PEARS BRING \$1 FOR 11-QT. BASKET

Plums 55 To 75 Cents On Local Market.

Tomatoes were the feature of the vegetable offerings on the local market today. Forty to 50 cents was paid for first quality, while second quality brought 25 to 35 cents. Potatoes were scarce. Pumpkins were on sale at 10 to 25 cents each, according to quality and size.

In the fruit market plums and pears were the main feature, the former prices ranging from 35 to 75 cents per 11-quart basket. Pears are offered at \$1 per 11-quart basket for first quality. Apples are plentiful, the Duchess variety being the main feature. Numerous loads of muskmelons were on sale, in the majority of cases the price being \$3 to \$3.50 per bushel and 10 to 20 cents each, according to quality and size.

LIVERPOOL, Sept. 2. — Firmness in Liverpool cables and reports of frost in parts of the Canadian Northwest had a tendency to give wheat values an upward slant during the early dealings here to-day. On the advance there appeared a fair amount of selling by cash houses, however, which brought about
