A British subject anywhere within the Empire will be a British subject everywhere within the Empire before the close of the present session. The scheme arrived at between the Home authorities and the governments of the overseas dominions will come up for ratification in the House of Commons shortly. It is understood that it will also be ratified shortly by the governments of South Africa, Australia and New Zealand. The question, which was difficult of solution, has engaged the attention

of the Imperial authorities and the Dominion for several years.

A resolution is to be presented in parliament asking that parts for traction engines and other machines be admitted free of duty in Canada. That is a reasonable request. In view of the fact that the machine in the first place must pay duty on entering Canada, it is only right that a farmer who suffers the inconvenience of breakage shall not only secure his needed parts at the lowest possible cost, but that as little delay as possible be caused in obtaining them.

Dr. Johnston, of Elm street, Toronto, tells us that it is time the newspapers all over Canada exploded the idea that the proper treatment of frost bites is to rub with snow. He says that frozen feet ought to be immersed in hot water, and that hot water is much more rapid and complete in its effects. This has been proven by practice during many years, yet people adhere to the old way, probably because snow is nearly always available while hot water is not. But Dr. Johnston states that a general knowledge of the efficacy of hot water in treating frozen limbs might prevent a great deal of suffering.

Helping the Poor Litigant

An interesting departure is about to be made in England for the purpose of enabling poor persons, unable to secure redress of grievance because of want of means, to obtain, without charge, the necessary legal advice and assistance. The new department will submit the various cases for opinion, and the rules governing its operation are now in course of preparation by the lord chancellor, the master of the rolls, the president of the probate, divorce and admiralty division, Mr. Justice Pickford and other members of the bar. The rules are expected to come into force about May, and will be framed so that enquirers can readily and easily learn where to go. One department will handle all the cases submitted and will forward them to the appropriate division. Lists in each division will be kept of counsel and solicitors willing to report upon applications and to assist those whose cause of action is approved. No fees of any kind will be payable, but remuneration may be granted out of treasury funds.
