Shirley kept the best foldiers embodied in fome remote place, as a force to execute fome impolitick project. The conquest of Canada, and the attack upon Crownpoint, are recorded as specimens of the wild projects which were to employ the infant forces of Newengland. During this time, the frontiers sustained additional miferies, by having the fmall forces of the state deducted for purposes which could be of no immediate fervice to them. The favages committed frequent depredations on the defenceleis inhabitants, and the eafe with which they gained their prey, encouraged their boldnefs, and by fcattering in small parties, they were able to infest the whole frontier of Newhampshire, from fort Dummer on Connecticut River, to the loweft settlement on Merrimack. During this war, which is known by the name of the Cape Breton war, the town of No. 4 could hardly be faid to be inhabited ;
