## INTERIM TRADE AGREEMENT BETWEEN CANADA AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA EMBODYING THE RESULTS OF THE TARIFF NEGOTIATIONS WHICH WERE NEGOTIATED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XXVIII BIS OF THE GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE AT THE 1960-61 TARIFF CONFERENCE OF THE CONTRACTING PARTIES TO THE GENERAL AGREE-MENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE.

The Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America, having carried on tariff negotiations pursuant to Article XXVIII bis of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade at the 1960-61 Tariff Conference of the Contracting Parties to the General Agreement, and desiring to enter immediately into a definitive agreement without awaiting the preparation of <sup>a</sup> Protocol embodying the results of that Conference, agree as follows:

I

The provisions of each party's schedule annexed hereto shall be applied by it as if this Agreement were a Protocol of Supplementary Concessions to the General Agreement. II

The CONTRACTING PARTIES are requested to exercise the same function<sup>5</sup> with respect to the schedules annexed to this Agreement as they would exercise if these schedules were schedules to the General Agreement.

## III

This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature. However, the concessions set forth in the schedule of a party shall take effect, except as otherwise provided in such schedule, thirty days after the date on which that party has notified the other party of its intention to put such concessions into effect. A party which has put the concessions set forth in its schedule into effect shall have the right to suspend or withdraw them in whole or in part until such time as the other party gives such notification.

## IV

This Agreement shall terminate at such time as a Protocol to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade embodying the results of the 1960-61 Tariff Conference and incorporating the schedules annexed hereto enters into force.

DONE at Geneva this seventh day of March 1962, in the English and French languages, both texts authentic except as otherwise specified in the schedule annexed hereto.
