

Agency representatives should be prepared to split their forces for duplicate coverage, which may be necessary on one or two occasions.

Saturday, October 10

9:00 a.m. H.M.Y. *Britannia* ties up at Anse-au-Foulon.

10:00 a.m. Her Majesty and His Royal Highness debark from the Royal Yacht at the Anse-au-Foulon (Wolfe's Cove) dock, where they will be greeted by the Lieut. Governor and Mme Comtois, Premier and Mme Lesage, the Mayor of Québec and Mme Hamel.

Royal Salute and Inspection of the Guard of Honour will take place within the dockside arrival shed, while the *Britannia* remains visible at docks from the heights above.

(Normal coverage, but no subsequent possibility of same press group covering the arrival of the Royal Couple at the Legislative Buildings, since press buses must follow the route of the procession. The closing of all other routes will block quick exit from the dock. The cavalcade will proceed by way of the Plains of Abraham.)

10:00 - The Royal Couple will leave Anse-au-Foulon
10:25 p.m. and arrive at the Parliament Buildings where they will be greeted by Premier and Mme Lesage. They will then proceed to the Legislative Council Chamber where Her Majesty will ascend the Throne. The Premier of Quebec will deliver a five-minute speech commemorating the second meeting of the Fathers of Confederation and Her Majesty will make a brief reply.
