The Secretary of State for External Affairs presents his compliments to the Ambassador of the United States of America and has the honour to refer to the Ambassador's Note No. 141 of December 22, 1961 containing a request for a further extension of permission to use the Haines Cut-off Road in the Yukon for the winter maintenance of the Haines-Fairbanks pipeline.

The Secretary of State for External Affairs is pleased to grant the extension until July 1, 1963 as requested on the understanding that the conditions set forth in sub-paragraphs (a) to (h) of his Note No. 13 of January 16, 1957 will apply. The Secretary of State for External Affairs is also pleased to confirm that in the event that snow removal operations on the road become necessary, the assistance of the Canadian Army's Northwest Highway System will continue to be available on a reimbursable basis in accordance with the conditions outlined in the Embassy's Note No. 158 of December 10, 1957.
