The Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of
America have entered into a treaty and supplemental provisions regarding
the taxation of the income of individuals and the prevention of
a repeated invasion in the case of state taxes and suggestions signed at
Ottawa on June 1, 1928. The Government of Canada and the Government of
the United States of America have agreed to exchange ratification
instruments and have appointed as their respective plenipotentiaries
