

- (b) if no process for such execution exists, Canada may present to the Supreme Court of Justice of the Republic of Peru or other competent body a certified copy of a panel determination under Article 20(2) and Canada will be entitled to execute it in the panel determination in Peru as if it were a final ruling issued by a Court in Peru. The panel determination will be a clear, express and executable obligation pursuant to the rules on the execution of rulings in force in Peru and therefore will not require to be recognized and follow an exequatur in Peru.

5. Any change by the Parties to the procedures adopted and maintained by each of them pursuant to this Article that has the effect of undermining the provisions of this Article shall be considered a breach of this Agreement.
