The Canada-United Kingdom Tax Agreement, which has been in force since 1946, was extended today to cover the Governments of British Guiana and St. Lucia.

This was formally effected by an exchange of notes between the Canadian and United Kingdom Governments under the provisions of the existing Agreement. This extension raises to twenty-three the number of colonial territories of the United Kingdom now covered by the Agreement. In September, 1951, twenty-one other colonial territories were accorded a similar extension, which widened substantially the scope of beneficial tax arrangements covering Canadian trade and investments abroad.

Details regarding the time of coming into force of these new provisions, as well as a list of all the territories affected by the Agreement, will be found in the Canada Gazette.
