THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS HAS BEEN INFORMED BY NATO SECRETARIAT THAT LORD ISMAY, SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANIZATION ANNOUNCED THE NAMES OF THE SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES FOR 1957-58 NATO FELLOWSHIP AND SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS ON APRIL 4, 1957.

MR. GERARD BERGERON, PROFESSOR AT LAVAL UNIVERSITY, WAS ONE OF 12 PERSONS AWARDED FELLOWSHIPS. SIX SCHOLARSHIPS ALSO HAVE BEEN AWARDED.

THIS IS THE SECOND FELLOWSHIP AND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME SPONSORED BY THE NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANIZATION TO PROMOTE THE STUDY AND RESEARCH OF SUCH HISTORICAL, POLITICAL, CONSTITUTIONAL, LEGAL, SOCIAL, CULTURAL, LINGUISTIC, ECONOMIC, SCIENTIFIC AND STRATEGIC PROBLEMS AS REVEAL THE COMMON TRADITIONS AND HISTORICAL EXPERIENCE OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC AREA CONSIDERED AS A COMMUNITY, AND GIVE INSIGHT INTO ITS PRESENT NEEDS AND FUTURE DEVELOPMENT.
