of sovereignty-association and renewed federalism and any other option can be examined ... thoughtfully, and in depth. It is our job to reflect the voices and the opinions which must be heard on these options ... all of the voices which are relevant to a decision in the referendum. There is, first, the voice within Quebec which says "yes" to sovereigntyassociation, and "no" to federalism, however it may be changed or renewed. There is secondly, the voice within Quebec which says "no" to sovereignty-association, and "yes" to a renewed or evolving federalism. And there are, thirdly, the voices outside Quebec which will be expressing themselves as to the feasibility, or acceptability, of sovereignty-association, or of a renewed federalism. These are the three voices which are in play and which must be heard. And it is our job in the CBC to reflect these voices fully and fairly and in equitable balance. This is what we mean to do with full and firm fidelity to our public trust ... with all the journalistic and broadcasting professionalism at our command".

Journalistic Programming

Our French and English radio and television networks have developed program plans to meet the critical and complex task I have described.
