Mr. Speaker: I declare the motion lost. The next question is on Motion No. 7. I take it that the vote should be applied in the same way. Mr. Malépart, seconded by Mr. Baker moves:

Motion No. 7

That Bill C-70, be amended in Clause 5 by striking out lines 26 to 47 at page 3 and lines 1 to 8 at page 4 and substituting the following therefor:

"Minister may, five years after the disappearance of the child, issue a certificate declaring that the child is presumed to be dead and thereupon the

child shall be deemed for all purposes of this Act to have died on the date the certificate is issued.

(2) If, after issuing a certificate under this section, the Minister is satisfied from new information or evidence that the child named in the certificate is alive, the Minister shall forthwith revoke the certificate and cause to be paid any allowance that would have been payable in respect of the child if the certificate had not been issued.

(3) For the purposes of this section, the Minister is not bound by the issuance or revocation of a death certificate by any other authority."
