I have already mentioned the havock made by the Highlanders: the bullet and bayonet are decent deaths, compared with the execution of their fwords.---Happy in escaping unhurt, I travers'd the field of battle, while strewed with bleeding carcasses, and covered with unemployed arms: a neat filver-mounted hanger, fastned to the side of an apparently headless trunk, and which confequently was useless to its orignal French possessor, attracted my attention. When the body was turned over, in order to unbuckle the belt, my afto--nishment was indeed great: his head -lay under his breaft, one stroke upon the back of his neck, having cut thro' the whole, except a small part of the **fkin**
