### Claims in Tisdale Well Picked Over

And Prospective Buyers Are Leth to Take on Absolutely Undeveloped Properties.

PORCUPINE CITY, April 11.—(From Our Man Up North.)—Claims in the Township of Tisdale have been picked over at a bargain sale, and claims that have been turned down by private buyers are now being put into stock companies. Buyers are leaving the camp regularly, satisfied that the real good things are now being placed under the hammer, and that no one can touch them for several months.

Western men who have been here looking over the camp and who did want claims for mining purposes are packing and leaving till the summer is on. They have not found claims at their price, and are now willing to wait till a later date.

"We are satisfied that there are many good leads in the camp which are true and genuine," said one of the "World-to-day," "but we are not satisfied to take them, undeveloped as they are, at the prices offered, for the best claims have been sorted out, leaving the dunks so far as the work now shows up."

### TO PAY FOR WRECKED RAILWAY

Japanese Loan to China—Charged With Selling Human Flesh.

SEATTLE, Wash., April 14.—A topic of discussion in Japan when the steamship Kamakura departed from Yokohama, on March 28, was the loan of \$5,000,000 by Japanese banks to the Chinese communication department, the money to be expended for railway purposes. The interest on the loan was 5 per cent, and the rate of interest five per cent. The money will be used to pay for the Peking-Hankow Railway, wrecked under pressure by the Chinese Government.

Lawlessness continues in Manchuria. Six Japanese were killed recently in a village on the Chinese Eastern Railway.

While a party of Russian soldiers were proceeding along the border near Harbin they were fired at by 200 Chinese troops. The Russians fled. The abatement of the plague in Manchuria continues. Kumatao Hishihara, in charge of the crematorium in Kuzibayaba, was arrested March 25 charged with selling human flesh. According to the Kokumin and other Tokyo papers, a search resulted in finding a large quantity of human flesh, either roasted or salted, and ten human tongues preserved in pots.

### TWO AVIATORS FALL

CHEVREUSE, France, April 14.—Lt. Bysse of the navy, while making an aeroplane flight here to-day, fell with his machine, and was mortally injured.

REIMS, France, April 14.—A monoplane, driven by M. Delange, collapsed when at a height of 100 metres to-day, and the aviator was seriously injured.

### Golden City To Have Pure Drinking Water

Pumping Plant to Be Installed on Vane Township to Serve Townsite.

PORCUPINE CITY, April 11.—(From Our Man Up North.)—Pure water for Golden City within a short time is now practically assured by the placing of the 40-horse power boiler and two enormous pumps on the apex of the Vane township to the east of the railway tracks near a creek which is fed by a spring. The creek empties into Bobs Lake and this lake will also be utilized for drinking water purposes.

The management of the Vane township is preparing to lay the pipes now that the boilers are installed, and the pumps ready to be cemented in place. All along King-street, the main thoroughfare in Golden City, water pipes will be extended from King-street back each way on the principal side streets.

The water pipes will not be extended to Porcupine City, and those who want the pure water from Bobs Lake, the only spot in this section where pure water was found by the government's tests, will have to arrange to go to Golden City.

The Porcupine Trust, which controls the Vane Township, and the telephone office, are moving their headquarters to Golden City. The main telephone office will be stationed in that town as soon as the building can be erected.

### SIX ATTEMPTED SUICIDES

Good Friday Fruitful in Tragedy at Philadelphia.

PHILADELPHIA, April 14.—Six persons, five men and one woman, attempted to commit suicide here to-day. Two of the men were successful. Emil Stebe, aged 42 years, a dealer in artificial flowers, killed himself with a revolver. He had been in ill-health. Gustave Orberman ended his life with gas because his wife had deserted him.

### EDITOR EARNED TO DEATH.

CLAREMONT, N.H., April 14.—Samuel Henry Storey, editor of the Narrator, a weekly publication, met a tragic death to-day. While apparently asleep on a sofa in his apartment, he died from an overheard stove communicated to the furniture and burned him to a crisp.

Storey lived alone in his newspaper office, and according to his own statement lived on nine cents a day. He was one of the oldest publishers in the state, having been born in 1833. He had no relatives so far as known.
