A. W. Huntley's Barn and Contents Destroyed—Old Man Found Dead From Heart Failure.

WOODSTOCK, Aug. 11.—(Special)—A fierce electric storm visited the Oxford district between the hours of 12 and 1 o'clock last night and considerable damage to the crops was done.
