### DEATH DUE TO WAR.

Lord Roberts is credited by The London Daily News with corroborating the view that the war was responsible for the Queen's death. In a speech at Manchester he said:

"I cannot help thinking that but for the intense anxiety caused by the war in South Africa, and by the deep sorrow which the Queen felt for the loss of our Gracious Majesty's devoted sailors and soldiers, and of her own grandson, she might have been with us."

"The Queen is right," says the London Daily News, "the death of the Queen certainly not the least loss which we have suffered."

"When I took my leave of the grateful people of London, in the early afternoon of the 10th of January, 1890, Her Majesty said to me then to be back in six months, and I was away for many years, when I next saw her on my return from South Africa, although only twelve or thirteen months had passed. I had then seen her only once, and she had not been to the same place. Those twelve months had been twelve months of the most trying and anxious of my life, and I had seen the whole Empire, but more especially the beloved sovereign, who had been so long away from her people, who had taken part in the war, and showed me many different ways how kindly she was for all their sufferings and privations."
