

MEDICAL OFFICER'S REPORT.

I have met with no occurrence in my department during the past year of sufficient interest or importance to justify a lengthened report.

I have only 9 deaths to record: one child, aged 7½ years, and 8 adults, ranging from 58 to 83, but averaging 71 years each.

Only one has died since the 19th of June, and there has been no death from preventible diseases.

Several have been taking medicine every day for many years, and are alive yet. They would feel sadly neglected if it were not given them, and as it appears to afford them so much pleasure, they are not sent empty away.
