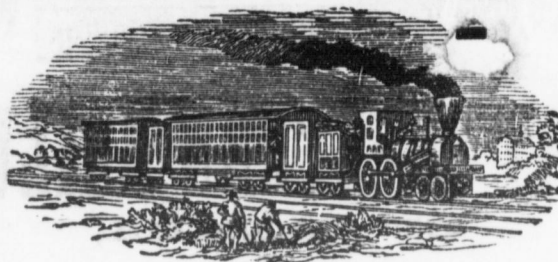

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CONNECTIONS.

1. **TORONTO.**—Trains connect with all Grand Trunk and Great Western Trains. for HAMILTON and SUSPENSION BRIDGE.
2. **KING.**—Stages daily to BOND'S LAKE.
3. **AUROEA.**—Stage daily to LLOYDTOWN.
4. **BRADFORD.**—Stage daily to BOND HEAD and COOKSTOWN.
5. **BARRIE.**—Stage daily to ORILLIA ; and Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays to PENETANGUISHENE. Trains stop at ALLENDALE for REFRESHMENTS.
6. **COLLINGWOOD.**—Steamer *Clifton* and Stage daily to THORNBURY, MEAFORD, CAPE RICH, and OWEN SOUND.
