How to Prepare the Delicious Pineapple.

THE pineapple, which appears in northern markets with the southern strawberry, should be used as freely during its short season as its more brilliantly colored fruits, and while its digestibility may be questioned on account of the extraordinary amount of tough fibre it contains, it has all the valuable fruit acids, and a remarkable substance, a vegetable pepsin, that digests all albuminous matter.

syrup with one quart of water and a pound of granulated sugar. Boil fifteen minutes so that a thick syrup is formed. Pare the pineapple and pick it in a small pineapple chopped fine and sprinkle two tablespoonfuls of sugar over it and let stand two hours before using the fruit juice and shreds to remain in the warm syrup until entirely cold, about an hour, if convenient. Then put in a freezer and when the little crystals begin to form on sides stir in the well beaten whites of three eggs, return to freezer and finish.

Frozen Pineapple Custard. Put one pint of milk on to scald in double boiler. Beat the yolks of three eggs light with a small cup of sugar, add the milk, stirring well and return to the boiler, stir and cook until smooth and creamy, then remove from fire and cool. When cold add a cup of sweet cream and the beaten whites of the eggs. Place in a freezer and freeze until almost solid, then stir in small pineapple chopped fine and thoroughly heated with half a cup of sugar, which should be sifted over it three hours before cooking. Ice and let it stand two hours or longer before serving.

Pineapple Bavarois. Pare a nice ripe pineapple and shred from the core. Put into a preserving pan with one cup of granulated sugar, a cup of water, and cook over a moderate fire and cook gently until tender, stirring frequently. Soak half a package of gelatin in half a cup of cold water. When the pineapple is done rub thru a sieve and place over a strainer in a pan of cracked ice, then fold in a pint of whipped cream. Turn into a mold, cover and close securely. Let stand in a pan of cracked ice and let it stand two hours or longer before serving.

Pineapple Pudding. Chop a quart of a pound of best sugar, very fine and mix with half a pound of sifted flour, a little salt and sufficient cold water to make a paste. With this line the sides of a buttered basin and put in about half a grated pineapple and a liquor glass of curacao. This should about half fill it. Cover with a thin layer of paste and pour a sweetened custard made with a cup of milk, two eggs and flavored with a little nutmeg, cover with more paste, tie up in a cloth with inverted plate over the top and steam for an hour and a half.

Pineapple Fritters. Pare and grate a pineapple, saving all the juice; add to this two cupfuls of sifted flour, the yolk of one egg, a little salt and a teaspoonful of melted butter, with enough water to make a batter thick enough to hold a drop from the end of the spoon for a moment or two. As soon as your fat is hot enough for frying quickly fold in the whites of the eggs, beaten to a stiff froth, and drop the batter by means of the tablespoon into the hot fat; fry the fritters a golden brown color. Remove them from the fat with a skimmer and drain a few minutes on tissue paper. Dust them with powdered sugar and serve quickly.

Pineapple Crusts. Place in a basin one pound of sifted flour, make a hollow in the centre and put in half a cake of compressed butter, then dissolved in a little warm milk. Add enough flour to make a good sponge, then stir in a warm cup of apple juice to be combined with two eggs, milk and gelatine it should be first heated to scalding, in order to destroy this digestive principle; otherwise, the digestive process being started, the preparation will have a bitter, unpleasant taste, and when milk is
