## DEATH OF CANADIAN WOMAN NOVELIST

Mrs. Everard Cotes, well known as a newspaper correspondent, died on Saturday at Ashland, Surrey, England.

Mrs. Sarah Jeanette Cotes, nee Duncan, was born at Brantford, Ont., in 1862, and married Everard Charles Cotes, managing director of the Indian News Agency, who has been in London for many years, and who came over to Canada with the Empire Press. Later, two years ago. In early life Miss Duncan was a public school teacher. Later, taking up journalism, she joined the editorial staff of the staff of the Toronto Globe, for which she wrote under the nom-de-plume of Garth Grafton. She was parliamentary correspondent for the Montreal Star in 1888. Afterwards, in

association with Mrs. Lillian Rood, she made a world tour, writing for the American and Canadian press, and producing in 1890 a book of travels entitled "A Social Departure." Later novels were "An American Girl in London," "The Simple Adventures of a Menzies," "The Pool in the Desert," "The Imperialist," "Cousin Cinderella," "The Burnt Offering" and other works. Mrs. Cotes had a bright, incisive style and wrote in a crisp and humorous vein.

## CLAIMS EXEMPTION FROM INCOME TAX

London, July 25.—The judicial committee of the privy council today granted a petition of Hon. J. E. Caron, member of the Quebec legislature, vs. the Attorney General of the Dominion, concerning the paying of income tax under the federal war tax act. The petition, which was not seriously opposed, raises the question of the validity of the federal measure and their Lordships, considering the matter of constitutional importance, granted the right to appeal.

Hon. Mr. Caron contended that, as a minister of the crown, he was not liable to income tax on his salary.

Holoken, N. J., July 25.—The Scandinavian-American liner Frederick VIII, from Copenhagen and Christiania, narrowly escaped destruction in a storm 190 miles at sea on Sunday night. She arrived in port today.

She carried 435 passengers. At the height of the storm, Captain Mechlenburg said the seas washed over the boat decks. Rain fell in torrents and the vessel was carried far out of her course. At one time the bow of the ship narrowly missed a sixty foot whale.
